A lot of exciting changes have been happening in the world of Paperwork in 2010; here is the latest news:

- ***Exhibiting at Maison et Objet.*** In January I joined 5 Design Factory designer/makers from the East Midlands region to showcase new work at France's leading international trade show. With over 2,000 stands exhibiting across 7 halls, ***Maison et Objet*** is a major international showcase for interiors, furniture, giftware, tableware & accessories.
- ***From April 2010 Paperwork has a new home.*** After 4 great years at Banks Mill Studios in Derby, I moved into a new, larger studio space in Nottingham, located in the same building as Stuart Akroyd Contemporary Glass.

- ***Award for Lincolnshire Libraries*** - produced from discarded books provided by Lincolnshire Libraries. I am very happy to be making the award for the 12 - 14 year category winner. The award is now in its seventh year & aims to encourage young people to read books for pleasure. Young people nominate books, choose the shortlist & vote for their favourite.
